This year, EPH Conference and EUPHA introduced an Abstract Mentor Programme providing an opportunity for young and/or less experienced abstract submitters to receive feedback from experienced reviewers. The programme was targeted at researchers who have limited access to colleagues to ask for guidance and comments on their proposed abstracts.

We are glad to announce that the Abstract Mentor Programme was a great success! We received a total of 28 abstracts of which 17 were submitted and accepted for the conference, which is a great start for this new programme. We used 15 mentors across Europe and many more expressed their interest. Thank you very much for all your support!
