## 4. Plan for next year

- a. At annual conference in Milan: Enni has been asked by Finnish researchers to organise a pre-conference event.
- b. Simon Capewell and Modi Motswama had expressed expectations for continuation of the discussion at this year's joint section and WHO WS on a possible healthy nutrition convention (there were 46 people at the WS, what should be considered as a good attendance); Natalie proposed to continue the work on a convention on nutrition as well, Chris will ask WHO if they are ready to continue co-operation, what is their agenda and what kind of WS would they be interested in.
- c. A pre-conference on sustainable eating in cooperation with a local health agency from Milan (but it would need to be somehow associated with EUPHA); alternatively, perhaps this event might be considered for inclusion in the main conference

- programme; Enni and Alessandra will prepare a draft programme for this preconference, and will explore interest with other potential contributors.
- d. The preparatory Committee meeting in March had been very useful, so we should plan another also for next year in Spring.
- e. Dario was asked if he could also propose a WS on food hygiene but doubts were expressed as to whether there are enough Section members interested in this, and it was agreed that we should explore how this topic might be integrated into the future work of the Nutrition Section.
- f. At next year's Milan welcome reception, healthier snacks than those offered in Glasgow should be provided; a word with the organisers is needed, if possible.
