- Successful team management experience, interest in multidisciplinarity, ability to work collaboratively and efficiently, resilience, commitment, flexibility, and organizational skills;
- Willingness to assume an important role in the Faculty of Biology and Medicine (FBM) of the University of Lausanne (UNIL);
- Fluency in written and spoken French and English (C1 level); good knowledge of German is an asset.
