# PUBLIC HEALTH FOR THE FUTURE OF HUMANITY: ANALYSIS, ADVOCACY AND ACTION

The theme of the Congress, *Public Health for the Future of Humanity: Analysis, Advocacy, and Action*, reflects our firm commitment that we, in the global public health community, have an obligation to respond to emerging global threats and challenges. We must hold to account those with the power to make a difference. We must act, making real our commitment to health in all policies. In a series of eight plenary sessions we will further explore these challenges and actions.

#### Leading the way to a healthier world

In the first two plenaries we look at what happened to our principles of the Enlightenment: evidence and reason. These principles are under attack from politicians and vested interests. In the second plenary we ask people from different backgrounds how we can work together to tackle global challenges and threats. In the third plenary session we look for leadership. We need individuals who can inspire, motivate, and influence those who can promote health and who can confront those who undermine it. Read more here.

#### The Digital Information Revolution

In the fourth plenary, we have a critical look at what the digital information revolution has brought us. The information we can access can empower individuals and communities, providing knowledge that would once have been inaccessible. It offers us choices that they could never have imagined.
