

NETWORKING AT EPH CONFERENCE



LATE BREAKER SESSION

We organize a late breaker session, titled **COVID-19 in the Global South: global and regional dimensions of pandemic responses**, on Friday 12 November, 12:40-13:40 CET. This session brings the much needed global perspective on vaccine progress and challenges in Africa and Asia. Inequitable access continues to experience a surge in infections and will make it difficult to end the pandemic. There was an urgent warning from WHO Director Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus saying that “no one is safe until everyone is safe”. Panel members will also share crucial insights into the role of the pharmaceutical companies and possible government strategies to improve better access.
