




Our Agency

Liaises with National Focal Points (NFPs)








Project management lifecycles


General rules from submission to award



Grants

Grants are financial contributions from the European Union budget awarded by way of a donation to a third-party (= the beneficiary) engaged in activities that serve Union policies

A grant is a donation to finance



Grants fall into two broad categories:


1. Grants for actions intended to help achieving objectives that are part of a Union policy

2. Operating grants

that finance the functioning of a body whose objectives are part of a Union policy. These are based on a work programme The successful applicant for a grant becomes the "beneficiary".
 We can have mono-beneficiary and multi-beneficiary

(Co-)Funding rates for grants


EU4Health:

- Action grants: up to 60% of eligible costs are co-financed, unless specified otherwise in the specific calls for proposals
- In cases of exceptional utility, the contribution by the Union may be up to 80% of eligible costs
- Direct grants (e.g. WHO, ERNs, etc): contributions of up to 100% possible

* Indirect costs included as a flat rate of 7% of the direct eligible costs







Part A – Administrative Form

- Fill online (not to be downloaded)
- Title, duration, abstract, keywords (page 2)
- Confirm declarations (page 3)
- Contact details of partners (section 2)
- Overview budget (section 3, verify against detailed budget)

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
Validate and correct warning errors (marked in red)




Part B – Technical narrative

- Problem analysis, general and specific objectives, linked indicators (process, output, outcome/impact)
- Target groups, political relevance, methods and means, expected outcome (!)
- Work packages (WP for short; some mandatory), deliverables (mainly public scope), risk analysis, timeline
- Budget: staff efforts by work package, contributions by third parties, detailed budget table


