ABSTRACT SUBMISSION RESULTS

We received 2,316 abstracts for single presentations and 255 abstracts for workshops. Abstracts have been reviewed and you can access the decision on your abstract by logging into your personal account here. Accepted abstracts are published in the Abstract Supplement of the European Journal of Public Health but only if you have registered for and presented at the Dublin conference.

NEXT STEPS FOR ACCEPTED ABSTRACTS

If your abstract is accepted, these are your next steps:

- 1. **Corrections**: check your abstract by logging into your personal account <u>here</u>. The system accepts your corrections until **15 July 2023**, noon (12.00 CET).
- 2. **Registration/confirmation**: confirm that you are presenting your abstract by registering for the conference before **15 July 2023**. If you do not register your abstract will not be included in the conference programme and the Abstract Supplement of the *European Journal of Public Health*. If you are organizing a workshop, all your presenters must register. **Read more**.

You may apply for a waiver if you are an oral, pitch or poster presenter, speaker or panellist in a workshop, or are active in one or more EUPHA/EPH Conference committees (e.g. International Scientific Committee or EUPHA Governing Board).
