EPH Conference Lisbon 2024 Statement

Key Resolutions:

Fostering Responsible and Equitable Innovation for Sustainable Public Health

By integrating sustainable practices and innovative solutions, including digital health technologies, we aim to reduce health disparities, improve public health outcomes, and protect both human and planetary health. Strengthening Policy and Advocacy

Effective public health policy is essential for building resilient health systems. We will bridge science, policy, and communities by fostering cross-sectoral collaborations and advocating for evidence-informed policies that address public health challenges. Our goal is to create stronger connections between researchers, policymakers, and communities to ensure that scientific knowledge drives policy innovation at both European and national levels.

Empowering People and Enhancing the European Health Data Space

People are at the heart of public health. We are committed to empowering individuals, giving them access to their health data and promoting active participation in management of their health care as well as continue advocating for people to have more control over the use of their own health data.

By advancing the European Health Data Space, we aim to ensure secure data exchange, improve healthcare delivery, and foster personalized care and public health research that benefits everyone.

Call to Action:

We call upon all stakeholders—public health professionals, policymakers, researchers, advocates, and citizens—to join us in this mission. Together, we can foster responsible, affordable, and equitable innovations to create a sustainable and healthier future for all.

- Promote Innovation: Advocate for inclusive and cost-effective solutions that benefit all sectors
 of society as well as increasing the readiness for the swift adoption and scaling up of innovations
 that are driven by actual health needs
- Develop Sustainable Practices: Implement policies that prioritize sustainability and health equity, addressing the social, environmental, and commercial determinants of health.
- Enhance Collaboration: Strengthen partnerships across sectors and communities to address complex public health challenges through innovative solutions, with a strong focus on stronger collaboration between public health and primary health care services.
- Champion Evidence-Informed Policies: Advocate for and implement policies that are rooted in scientific evidence and ensure resilient health systems.
- Empower People: Ensure people have access to their health data and are active participants in management of their health care. Encourage and enable people to be part of health governance as well as co-creation in policy development regarding the social/environmental/commercial determinants of health.
- Support the European Health Data Space as a means to improve healthcare delivery and research.

By working together and embracing innovation through the lens of equity, sustainability, and participation, we can harness the power of science, policy, and society to navigate public health challenges and create a more inclusive and healthier future in Europe.


