Background

Many public health issues can be better targeted on international level than on national level alone. To become "part of the international game" it is important for young scientists to create a personal network. Purpose

How to do it?

After 6 minutes, 4 more minutes are provided for discussing. Consequently, each group spends 10 minutes together. Afterwards, new groups with different participants are created – and the speed dating continues.
