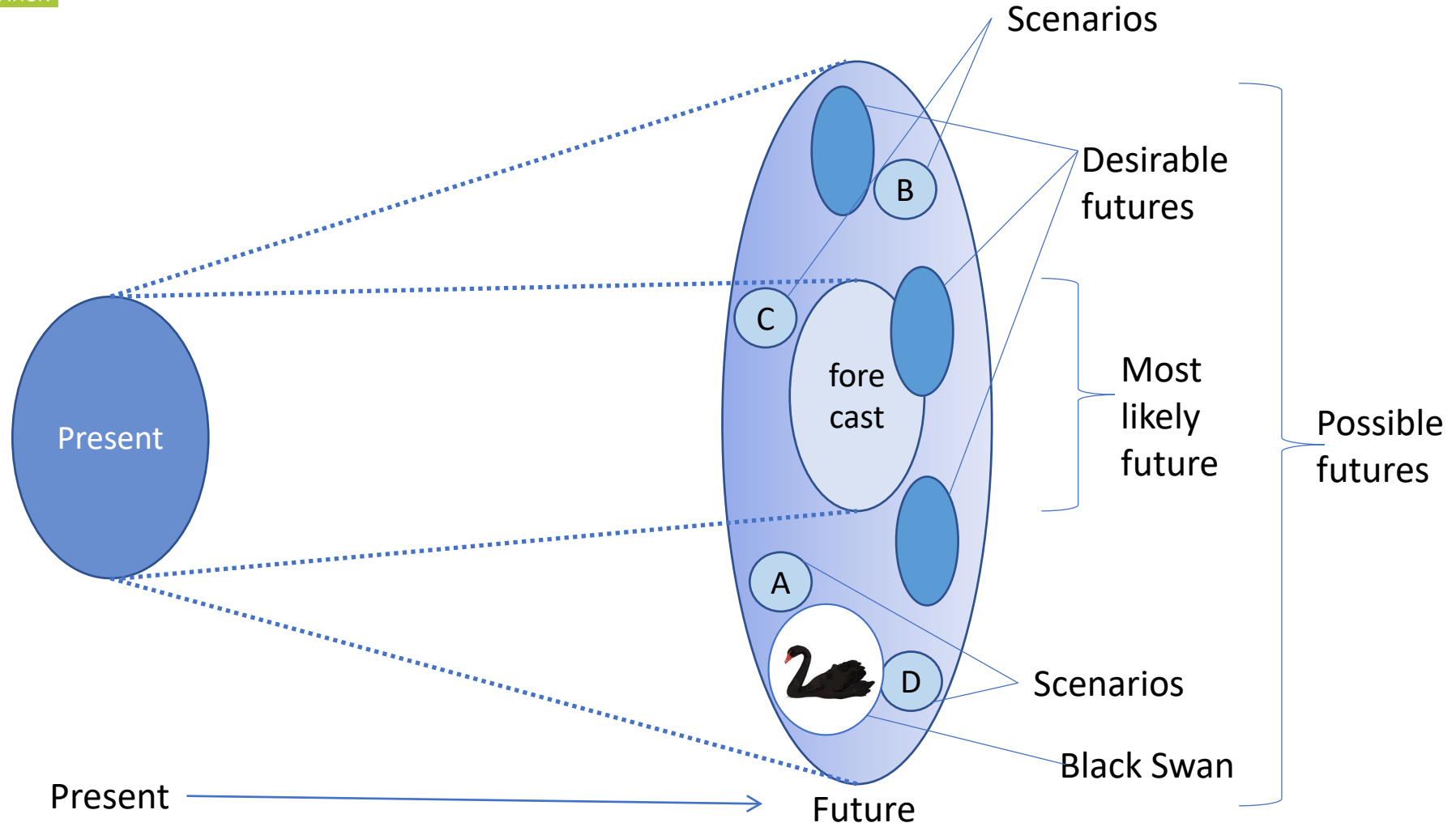
Introduction

Exploring the future...

- **Foresight does not predict the future, but rather explores a range of plausible futures.** The objective is not to focus on certainty, but to expand and reframe the range of plausible developments that need to be taken into consideration, e.g. **to support policy making.**
- Foresight uses a range of methodologies, such as scanning the horizon for emerging changes, analysing megatrends and developing scenarios, to reveal and discuss useful ideas about the future.
- Scenario development, horizon scanning, trends analysis, future outlooks, forecasting,...
