- 4. Chronical diseases
- 5. Health inequality

As the interest of young people is not reflected in (health) policy, we should work on integrated health topics and addressing stakeholders on the right level.

One of the ideas was to organize a participatory workshop on engagement of parents and children/adolescents. Can they act as an advisory group? Can we share materials and best practices on this subject?

We were happy that everyone left their names and email addresses, so we can expand our CAPHnetwork. We will organize several online meetings coming year to exchange knowledge and work together on the above mentioned topics.
