Followed in both cases by facilitated discussion -Results summarized in themes below:

Research Priorities and challenge Currently include ways of tackling the obesity epidemic and using a participatory research approach to build effective interventions School closure and mental health -mental health- lack of data health inequalities- Impact of poverty on child and adolescent health UK Budapest: chronic disease, asthma obesity addictive behavior Health literacy Access to data on mental health, obesity Underrepresentation of youth in research Solutions Online methods of research offer opportunity to engage young people Several good examples- esp some forms of social media eg Instagram Challenged by infodemic Ethnicity research challenging to get right- participatory research undervalued Engagement of marginalised groups

Intersectionality – ignoring this overlooks disadvantage

Another challenge is GDPR
