BACKGROUND:

Demographic and socio-economic changes call for metropolitan expansion and urban renewal interventions that could strongly impact on Public Health.

In contrast to the quantitative aspect of urbanization legislations (planning rules), the qualitative aspect of indoor and outdoor living conditions (performances) are issues that need to be taken into consideration. These changes might give the opportunity to create resilient urban areas, promoting the development of new economies and employment that could tackle social inequalities, highlighted as a one of the key Public Health determinant, with strong reference to the Non-Communicable Diseases (NCDs) that represent the greatest amount of EU diseases..

The close connection between urban features and Public Health has been strongly underlined, as building hygiene and urban planning strategies play a central role for health promotion activities and support disease prevention management.

AIMS AND SCOPES:

Considering the EU scenario, the aim of this call for papers is to gather new and effective *Urban Public Health Researches, Policies and Practices* to bridge Designers and Public Health expertise, and to define how cities can improve population's Physical and Mental Health, promoting social inclusion and healthy lifestyles and therefore positively impact on NCDs' prevention.

Recent events, such as the COVID-19 pandemic, require an updated approach to the topic, to guide stakeholders in urban planning and designing choices, and a proactive management of the cities that are being transformed in healthy environments.

This Special Issue will be structured as follows:

- **Urban Health Research** (4 papers): reporting innovative studies conducted in urban contexts, like: qualitative and quantitative performance tools to measure cities' attitude to public health promotion, healthcare data collection to support urban strategies, urban accessibility researches, correlation studies between NCDs and built environment in metropolitan settings, etc.
- **Urban Health Policies** (4 papers): reporting effective strategies developed by Policy Makers, aimed at promoting physical, mental and social well-being of the population in urban contexts, like: sustainable mobility and walkability enhancement, urban regeneration to foster social inclusion, physical activity promotion and NCD prevention, etc.
- **Urban Health Practices** (4 papers): reporting experience-based applications in urban contexts, like: living spaces design and urban planning experiences, measured outcomes of urban policies application, study case and pilot studies report, etc.
