Activities @ Vienna conference 2016

Ideas for Stockholm 2017

The following ideas were discussed:

- Follow up Ethics and antimicrobial resistance. Discussing this in an interdisciplinary context. Could be a topic for pre-conference even? (Babette/Marten).
- Ethical competencies: practical and applied competencies / hands on case studies (Judy/Farhang/Peter).
- Skills building workshop: how to teach PHE (Silviya).
- Ongoing session on research ethics: framework to do transnational research (based on real life case) (William/Els).
- Small scale questionnaire @ Stockholm conference about knowledge of participants pertaining to existing education in their home institutions, experienced problems and needs of further knowledge in the area of research ethics and present the results in Ljubljana (Silviya).
- Taking the Stockholm theme and to discuss the role of community in shaping norms, values and their interpretation. E.g.: having one case study discussed from representatives of different (value) communities. (Massimiliano, postdiscussion after official closing of meeting).

Peter mentioned he would be in touch with Yves who organises Marseilles 2019 and discussing if / how ethics could play a role, e.g. in defining the themes of the conference.

Next steps

Circulating these minutes among people present, then within the whole section to see who else would like to contribute to / with what for submitting workshops etc. for Stockholm 2017.
