

# 2. Activities throughout the year

The section has conducted a second survey among the Section members about national health promotion activities. The detailed results were presented at the JTN and can be requested by the section president Luis Saboga-Nunes.

Following the Section release Statement on Health Promotion in the time of COVID-19 last year, - a cross-country and cross-organization work (included members from UNESCO and IUHPE and various academic institutions) a discussion about the first round & A second round was followed. The main aim of the discussion was to explore further on the five discussion points on the implications of the COVID-19 pandemic and shed light on needs and barriers from health promotion perspective. The discussion should enable health promotion practitioners and policy makers to learn from this crisis for future health promotion planning.

#### Research

 by disseminating EUPHA HPS activities and taking lead roles in the European Health Promotion Forum and the International Union for Health Promotion and Education as well as within our national and international health promotion research projects. For example COVID-HL Network (covid-hl.eu)

## Practice

• by collaborating specifically with schools and school network and implementing health promotion school concepts in diverse school settings. For example with the Schools for Health in Europe Foundation (SHE) and the International School Health Network (ISHN)

## Policy

• by starting policy dialogues in 2020 with European Region member states and policy makers with a focus on embedding health literacy within a European health promotion framework. For example joining the WHO European Region Action Plan Initiative on Health Literacy
