The "Join the Network on HSR"- meeting was attended by more than 30 people and many ideas came up for next year's conference.

HSRUK Annual Conference 2019: invitation to international HSR community

- On behalf of the <u>HSRUK</u> team we would like to invite you to join the 12th annual Health Services Research UK conference, to take place on 2-3 July 2019, in Manchester. We believe it will be an ideal opportunity to learn from a leading HSR conference in Europe, bringing together health services researchers, healthcare policymakers, clinicians and managers.
- As part of its ambition to collaborate internationally, HSRUK particularly welcomes non-UK participants and abstracts, in particular of research with an international dimension that will have a positive impact on patients and health services, build research capacity, or advance research methodology.
- The agenda for the conference is very broad this year conference plenaries will focus
 on topics like the impact of health services research and future priorities; social care
 research, policy and practice; using patient experience data in research and
 improvement; and research on the healthcare workforce.
- Abstract submission deadline of papers, posters and workshops is 13 January 2019. There

- Book your place at the <u>conference</u> and benefit from early bird registration fees, valid until 31 March 2019. We hope you'll join us at HSRUK19 for two days of cutting-edge research in an exciting programme of presentations, posters, themed sessions and workshops.

Update on TO-REACH initiative

- Our networks are supporters of <u>TO-REACH</u>, led by national governmental and funding bodies and aimed to prepare an international research programme on health services and systems research.
- The future research programme of TO-REACH is expected to become a part of the next EU Framework Programme, <u>Horizon Europe</u>, to run from 2021-2027, in light of its dedicated attention to health care systems.
- Before the summer, we invited HSR researchers to share their views on future research priorities, this to inform both a dedicated TO-REACH initiative and the wider Horizon Europe programme. We will share reports on the mapping early next year. For a first impression of outcomes, see this <u>presentation</u> at the EPH Conference, last November.
