| 4th INTERNATIONAL PUBLIC MENTAL HEALTH SUMMER SCHOOL 2018

PMH Section together with international partners is organizing the 4th **International Public Mental Health Summer School 2019 on “Research and Practice IN PUBLIC MENTAL HEALTH during the lifecourse”** at Vilnius University (Lithuania). It is a 5-day intensive and interactive course aimed at researchers, practitioners, policy makers and everyone interested in public mental health. Participants of the summer school will be granted 3-5 ECTS points and certificates.

AIM: The course aims to provide fundamentals and strengthen competencies on:

- the main concepts, theories and practices in public mental health
- core research methods in public mental health epidemiology/life course epidemiology
