Submitted abstracts will be scored centrally by EUPHA, before getting accepted for presentation at the conference. Only those contributions that are accepted for presentation at the conference will be eligible for the award. After acceptance as part of the program, each eligible abstract will be assessed based on scientific quality, study innovation, and public health relevance. Priority will be given to contributions from Eastern European countries and individuals who would otherwise be unable to raise funding to come to the congress. The winner of the award will be notified by the end of June 2019.
