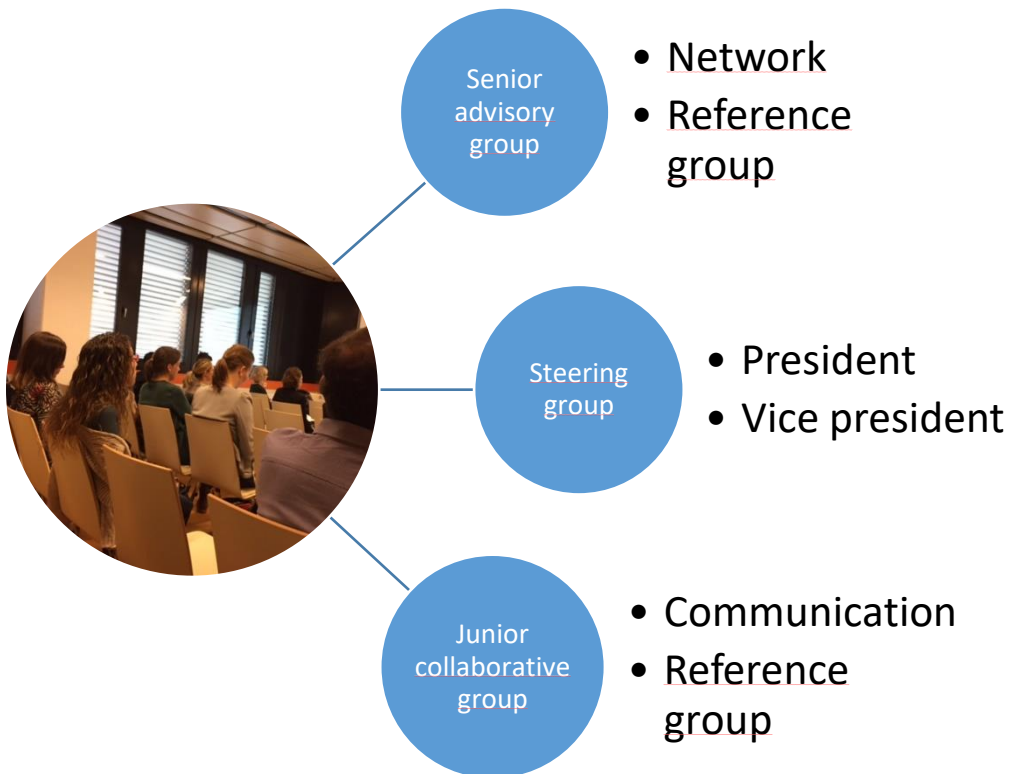


Minutes from the annual meeting of the EUPHA Section of Social Security Work and Health, 11 November 2016, Vienna

About 30 people present. Chair: Kristina Alexanderson

- Minutes from last annual meeting accepted.
- Gunnel Hensing and Ute Bültmann had been nominated as the new president and vice president respectively. There were no other nominations.
- Gunnel Hensing was unanimously elected as the new president of the Section.
- Ute Bültmann was unanimously elected as the new vice president of the Section.
- Kristina Alexanderson, the former president was thanked for her years as the president of the Section. Gunnel Hensing and Angelique de Rijk also talked some about the history of the Section – after several years of work, established in 2000.
- Gunnel Hensing presented her suggestion for the future organization of the Section, including a new senior advisory group and junior collaborative group. Future groups of the Section, as suggested by new president Gunnel Hensing:



- The members of organizing committee of this years' pre-conference (Jenny Head, Ewan Carr and Kristina Alexanderson) were thanked for their work in organizing a successful pre-conference on the theme: "Extending working life beyond the age of 50; challenges in cross-national research". This was the 14th pre-conference organized by the section for researchers in this area.
- Reflections on this year's conference, good conference and good level. Two problems were reported: the two workshops on the issues of the section were scheduled at the very same time. This was a great problem. Another problem was that one of the sessions in the printed programme was announced for the wrong room. Handling this took time from the scientific presentations and discussions.

- Some had not gotten information sent out – one reason can be having registered more than once as a member, with different e-mail addresses. Please check this.
- Information: Next year the EPH conference will start Thursday morning, in order to hold more sessions. This means that pre-conferences can only be held on the Wednesday.
- The conference next year will take place in Stockholm, Sweden 1-4 November 2017. The conference in 2018 will take place in Ljubljana and the one 2019 in Marseille, France.
