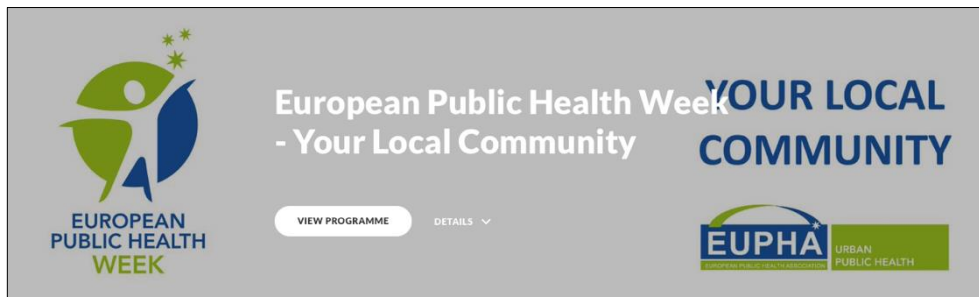
## Annual meeting
